



LNCS NUMTA2023 Conference Proceedings

Authors of one-page abstracts accepted for presentation at NUMTA2023 are invited to submit (optional) their original research papers for NUMTA2019 Proceedings to be published in an [LNCS volume](#) after the Conference.

Each submitted paper can be either a short paper (min 6 – max 8 pages in the LNCS format) or a long paper (min 12 – max 15 pages in the LNCS format) and should contain original research that has neither been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere. Springer requires that members of the Organizing and Scientific Committees cannot be co-authors of more than 2 papers.

The authors should pay the registration fee before submitting their paper for the NUMTA2023 LNCS Conference Proceedings. For each paper, at least one registration fee should be paid. All submitted papers will be regularly peer-reviewed and processed in the order received.

Authors must be aware that after the acceptance they will be invited to submit a signed License-to-Publish form, through which the copyright of their accepted paper will be transferred to Springer (click [here](#) for more details).

Authors should check the "[Springer's Instructions for Authors of Proceedings](#)" page (consult also [this pdf-file](#)), where they can download and must use the correct templates (LaTeX or Word) for the preparation of their papers (the LNCS LaTeX templates are available in [Overleaf](#) , as well). Springer encourages authors to include their [ORCID](#)s in their papers.

Each paper should fit (in the pdf format) the required length depending on the paper type (short or long). The pdf file of the paper has to be submitted through the [EquinOCS system](#) by using the same procedure as for [submitting a one-page abstract](#) (a separate new submission should be created for this purpose). Please make sure you choose the correct category of the paper ("LNCS short paper" or "LNCS long paper"). You may slightly change (with respect to the accepted one-page abstract) the paper title and, in exceptional cases, to modify the authors list.

Submission deadline: May 21, 2023.

Expected publication: End of 2023.
