



## LNCS NUMTA2026 Conference Proceedings

Authors of one-page abstracts accepted for presentation at NUMTA2026 are invited to submit (optional) their original research papers for NUMTA2026 Proceedings to be published in an [LNCS volume](#) after the Conference, using the same [submission form](#) as for the one-page abstracts.

Each submitted paper can be either a short paper (min 6 – max 8 pages in the LNCS format) or a long paper (min 12 – max 15 pages in the LNCS format) and should contain original research that has neither been published nor submitted for publication elsewhere. Springer requires that **each co-author may appear in at most two papers.**

Authors are required to pay the registration fee before submitting their paper to the NUMTA2026 LNCS Conference Proceedings. For each paper, at least one registration fee must be paid. All submitted papers covered by a registration fee will undergo regular peer review and will be processed in the order in which they are received.

Authors must be aware that after the acceptance they will be invited to submit a signed License-to-Publish agreement, through which the copyright of their accepted paper will be transferred to Springer (click [here](#) for more details).

Authors should check the “[Springer’s Instructions for Authors of Proceedings](#)” page (consult also [this pdf-file](#)), where they can download and must use the correct templates (LaTeX or Word) for the preparation of their papers (the LNCS LaTeX templates are available in [Overleaf](#) , as well). Springer encourages authors to include their [ORCID](#)s in their papers.

**Expected publication: End of 2026.**
