NUMTA 2023 YOUNG RESEARCHER PRIZE

The **Springer NUMTA 2023 Young Researcher Prize** is awarded to the best presentation made by a young scientist. The Prize consists of 500 Euros and a certificate.

The following **Rules** are applied:

- Submission deadline for applications is ~~May 21, 2023~~ **June 11, 2023** to be sent electronically at: numta2023 (at) dimes.unical.it with the subject NUMTA 2023 Young Researcher Prize.
- Applicants must be not older than 30 years on June 14, 2023 (i.e., born after June 14, 1993).
- Applicants should submit full papers to be considered for the Prize. Only authors of papers accepted for the Conference Proceedings (after their regular peer-reviewing) may participate at the competition.
- Applications are initially evaluated by the NUMTA 2023 Scientific Committee based on the relevance of the research, its impact, novelty, and the quality of the presentation. The final decision on awarding the Prize is made after presentations at the Conference.
- The Prize is awarded during the closing ceremony of NUMTA 2023.
- A detailed CV of the applicant must be included in the application, with a copy of an ID card or passport.
- Taxes on the Prize amount should be paid, if required.
- Applicants must ensure they have submitted all the documents required to be eligible for the award and to participate at the Conference as a speaker. Incomplete applications are not considered.
- Members of the Scientific and Organizing Committees are excluded from the competition.
